PRACTICE IS VERY IMPORTANT!

- The only way to improve is to go to practice
- WHILE WE ARE FOLLOWING STATE AND LOCAL GUIDELINES DUE TO COVID-19, THE 50% PRACTICE ATTENDANCE RULE IS WAIVED
- Temperature checks will be performed upon entry to each facility and masks are required until the swimmer enters the pool and upon exit of the facility
- We will adhere to USA Swimming lane restriction recommendations while following state and local COVID-19 guidelines



HOW ARE DUES/FEES APPLIED?

- Facility rental, maintenance, usage and permit fees




DUES PAYMENTS

- This season, the dues payments are applied as follows:
 - Upon registration, non-refundable payments of \$200 along with AMS and USA Swimming fees (\$83 total) were charged
 - September 15 \$200 payment along with a non-refundable \$75 family fundraising fee were charged
 - The balance of the swimmers dues will be divided through the months of October through January as long as we have practice in the water; should we find ourselves without a pool for a given month, payment will be suspended until we are back in the water
- Any questions or concerns regarding payments should be directed to our Treasurer, Tony Masztak
- Please be sure to check credit card expiration dates to ensure payments are processed in a timely manner

MEET ENTRY PROCESS cont'd

- Final entries are sent to the host meet representative
 - Depending on the meet, a charge of \$3 \$7 is charged per event for each swimmer
 - FINAL ENTRIES ARE NOT ABLE TO BE CHANGED, THEREFORE NO REFUNDS CAN BE ISSUED
- After the meet is over, results are posted to the website

HOME MEET STRUCTURE

- Each meet has two sessions per day
 - AM Session: 7:00 AM Noon*
 - PM Session: Noon 5:00 PM*

*These are general times and may vary based on timelines and job assignments

 Each age group will be assigned to a session and may vary between morning and afternoon



VOLUNTEERING AT HOME MEETS

- Each family MUST volunteer for TWO sessions per meet
 - That equates to four sessions during short course season
- Substitutes may be hired in the event you are unable to volunteer at a rate of \$60 per session
- A \$200 penalty will be charged per session for non-compliance of assigned jobs
 - Non-compliance means not showing up for your assigned time and/or not completing your entire volunteer session
- Sessions must be worked whether your child is swimming or not
 - Even if your child is not eligible to swim due to age group or becomes sick, all families are still required to volunteer to run a successful meet



BECOME AN OFFICIAL

- A Stroke & Turn Official and an Administrative Official counts as a volunteer job for ANSC home meets
- 6 apprentice sessions are required along with passing an online test
- Once the apprentice sessions and test are completed, 6 more sessions are required to earn a \$100 credit towards ANSC dues
 - Sessions must be completed by June 30
 - Credit will be received each year you remain certified and work the minimum number of sessions (12 sessions per season)
- We hope to have officials commit to working at least 2 sessions per ANSC hosted meet
- Great way to learn about the sport and be on deck

- Read all email messages and respond promptly if required
- Check the website for updates
 - Meet invitations
 - Meet entries
 - Final entries
 - Meet warm-up times
- Familiarize yourself with ANSC practice times and policies provided on the website
- VOLUNTEER fulfill volunteer sessions at ANSC-hosted home meets.
- BE SUPPORTIVE AND POSITIVE TO YOUR SWIMMERS!
